## REFRIGERATION NEEDED

Liverpool and Fairfield Congregations operate kitchens that feed the hungry. Liverpool Community kitchen and Hub is operating 5 days a week for breakfast and lunch. It has recently reopened with the help of grants from the PNP mission Development Fund and Uniting as well other community organisations. It is feeding up to 100 people per day.

Fairfield has long operated 'the Diner' on Monday and Wednesday each week and in the first 6 months of this year served app 7000 meals. Each of these are operated by volunteers, with paid staff oversighting at Liverpool, who come from the community. However, each of them is desperately in need of good quality commercial refrigeration and freezers or perhaps even walk in cool rooms.
